Promotion Criteria

1. For Primary Section I to VII.

For Classes I to V

A non-detention policy is favoured in classes I - V unless detention at a particular level is advised by the subject / class teacher.

For Classes VI to IX

- Student must pass in all subjects for promotion to the next higher class as per the rules of GSEB.
- Report Card will reflect grades as well as marks.
- It is imperative for a student to secure a passing grade in Art, Music, Dance, PE and activities offered.
- A student will repeat the year if he/she fails in any of the subjects as per the norms of GSEB.

2. For Class XI

Promotion is granted in accordance with the GSEB norms. (Gujarat State Board norms.)

3. FOR CLASSES X & XII.

To be eligible to appear in the Board Examination, clearing the Terminal and the Preliminary Examination along with 80% attendance is mandatory.



ATTENDANCE :

A minimum of 80% attendance is mandatory for promotion to the next class at all levels.

4. For Choice of Science Stream in Class XI marks obtained in 1st and 2nd Prelims of Std X and Board Examination will be given equal weightage as per the decision of the School.

Note : For assessment in all classes :

- (a) conduct and discipline
- (b) regularity
- (c) participation in school activities and sports are also taken into consideration.
